

Visit Update

As we are sure you are all aware, Suffolk is in Tier 4. This means there have been some changes to our visiting regulations. Unfortunately we are only now able to accept visitors from <u>within</u> <u>Suffolk</u>, as travel into or out of any Tier 4 areas is not permitted. For visitors who are living in Suffolk, visits in our porch area can still continue as this is a COVID-safe way of visiting.

We have also introduced the following restrictions to our visiting:

Visitors <u>MUST</u> still report to Reception to have their temperature taken on arrival for their prebooked visit. All visitors <u>MUST</u> wear a mask at all times whilst in Reception, the main Reception door will only be unlocked once you have put on your mask to protect our administration staff.

Please reduce the amount of time spent in Reception to a minimum – we expect visitors to have their temperature taken and their details recorded by staff (for Track and Trace purposes) then immediately leave Reception to make their way round to the visiting area in the porch. There will also be a marked floor area in Reception to prevent visitors from standing too close to the Reception desk.

Please **<u>DO NOT</u>** return to Reception after your visit as there may be another visitor having their temperature taken. Any items to be dropped off for residents should be done prior to your visit and left behind the screen away from the Reception desk. It is imperative that our Receptionists or other staff are not approached within 2m to protect them and your loved ones.

Please ensure you wipe down the door handles, chairs and intercom in the visiting area with the wipes provided before **<u>AND</u>** after your scheduled visit.

Booking for your visits remains the same, with all visits being pre-booked via Reception. The above rules have been put in place to allow us to continue running visits and to ensure we keep everyone safe. We thank you all for following these rules when you visit Norwood House.

The residents danced their way through Christmas Eve in the lounge with Christmas Songs playing to get everyone in the Festive Spirit.














